Notice of New Supplemental RFP Document

Please be advised that Entergy Services, Inc. (ESI), as agent for Entergy Texas, Inc., has posted a new document identifying supplemental information that Bidders must provide in connection with Proposal Submission. The required information, which the current RFP documents do not expressly indicate will be sought, will be used in the evaluation of Bidders' proposals and/or the negotiation of definitive agreements. As the document indicates, Bidders will be asked to supply the information as part of their responses to questions or requests included in either the RFP Web Portal or one of the due diligence questionnaires (Appendix H, I-1, or I-2). The due diligence questionnaires will be updated to include the supplemental information requests specific to the questionnaires. The RFP Web Portal is in the process of being constructed and is expected to include, in addition to the requests alluded to in Appendix C and the RFP Main Body, the RFP Web Portal requests identified in the new document.

Please note that the new document does not necessarily capture all supplemental information that ESI will seek during Proposal Submission and is subject to modification prior to Proposal Submission. The document is being provided now in an effort to ensure that Bidders have adequate time to prepare proposals that meet the needs of the evaluation teams and otherwise satisfy the requirements of the 2011 Western RFP. Notification of any change to the document will be communicated through a similar notice.
