Notice of Release of Final RFP Documents and Bidder Registration

Entergy Services, Inc. (ESI) has released what are expected to be final documents for the 2015 Request for Proposals for Long-Term Developmental and Existing Capacity and Energy Resources (the ELL/EGSL RFP). These documents are available on the website for the ELL/EGSL RFP, <u>https://spofossil.entergy.com/ENTRFP/SEND/2015ELLEGSLRFP/Index.htm</u>. They reflect consideration of feedback received to date on the ELL/EGSL RFP from potential bidders and interested parties.

The final ELL/EGSL RFP documents issued on September 29, 2015 are intended to be definitive. The documents include updates to certain terms related to the scope and parameters of the ELL/EGSL RFP as compared to the draft ELL/EGSL RFP documents posted on the ELL/EGSL RFP website on July 27, 2015 and information provided at the August 17, 2015 Bidders Conference. To the extent differences exist, the final ELL/EGSL RFP documents will control. Unless otherwise instructed, Bidders should rely on the final ELL/EGSL RFP documents and ESI responses to Bidder questions in developing their proposals.

Bidders must complete Bidder Registration in order to participate in the 2015 ELL/EGSL RFP. Absent a superseding notice, Bidder Registration will begin at 8:00 a.m. CPT on November 2, 2015, and will be available until 5:00 p.m. CPT on November 5, 2015. Bidder must duly complete, execute, and deliver to the RFP Administrator during the Bidder Registration Period, electronically or via courier, the Bidder Registration Agreement. A Bidder's registration will not be complete until Bidder also submits to the RFP Administrator an original of the Bidder Registration Agreement that was submitted during the Bidder Registration Period. The original is due to the RFP Administrator no later than November 10, 2015, under the current ELL/EGSL RFP Schedule.

The RFP Hotline will be available to Bidders from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. CPT on each Business Day throughout the Bidder Registration Period. Bidders may use the RFP Hotline to ask technical questions regarding the Bidder Registration Process. The number for the RFP Hotline is 281-297-3758.
