

- 1) When will working (Microsoft Word) versions of the product package proposal registration forms be available to download from the website?
 - a. Working versions of the product package proposal submission forms will be available by January 31 in advance of the electronic proposal submission process which begins at 8:00 a.m. February 4, 2008.
- 2) The economic and operational project evaluation section of the CCGT and CT MUCPA product package proposal submission forms do not include field for start-up fuel requirements. Where should bidders include this information in the applicable product package proposal submission form?
 - a. Bidders should provide the start-up fuel requirements for the CCGT and CT MUCPA products in the last field of the “Special Considerations” section of the applicable proposal submission form.
- 3) The term sheets for the product packages include a section on QF Put. Do the terms of “No QF Put” only apply to the dispatched portion of the Capacity Quantity? In other words, will the seller be able to put any un-dispatched portion of the Capacity Quantity to the host utility?
 - a. The answer to both questions is No. As noted in the term sheet, in those hours during which Buyer does not Schedule and Dispatch all energy associated with the Capacity Quantity, Seller shall not be entitled to deliver to the host Entergy Operating Company, and the host Entergy Operating Company shall not be obligated to accept or pay for, energy associated with the undischatched portion of the Capacity Quantity.
- 4) On behalf of Bidder [REDACTED], Part 4 of the Proposal Submission Form (Fuel Supply and Transportation) for Peaking MUCPA contains requests for information that does not appear to be appropriate for the Bidder to provide if ESI is to provide the fuel supply for the Bidder's [proposal]. Only the information in fields 57-59 is within Bidder's knowledge and/or control. Rather than risk bid rejection due to an incomplete submittal, Bidder requests that ESI provide additional clarification regarding the specific information Bidder is expected to provide in fields 60-69.
 - a. Part 4, questions 60-69, of Product Package C requests information specific to the bidder's and/or the resource operator's experience with various aspects of fuel supply and transportation to and/or for the resource. To the extent there is no prior experience with fuel supply and transportation to and/or for the resource, Bidders are instructed to enter “N/A” in the applicable required field AND then explain the reason for this entry in Question #2 of the Special Considerations section.
